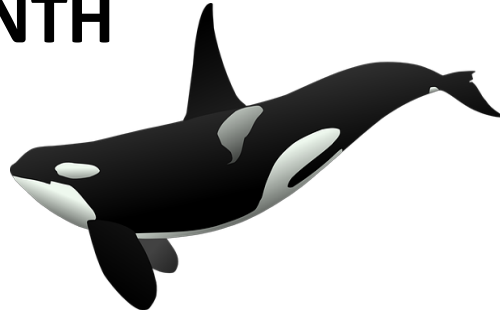


ORCA ACTION MONTH POSTER CONTEST!

For Ages
7-17



Sustainable Bainbridge and partners invite Bainbridge youth to participate in a poster contest to raise awareness and communicate actions we can take to protect our important and endangered Southern Resident Orcas!

Contest winners will have their posters displayed around the community in June as part of Orca Action Month, will win a family 4-pack of passes to the Seattle Aquarium, and will receive special City Council recognition.

Posters are accepted in sizes from 8.5"x11" to no larger than 11"x14" and should:

- Highlight that June is Orca Action Month
- Be visually compelling
- Communicate information about how we can act as individuals and/or as a community to protect orcas

Posters can be in any media, ex. paint, marker, digitally created, collage, etc.

Up to three winning posters will be selected, one from each of the following age groups:

- 7 to 10 years old
- 11 to 14 years old
- 15 to 17 years old

Participants must be residents of Bainbridge Island. Submissions will be accepted through **May 4, 2019**. Participants should take a photo of or scan their entry and **submit it to: watershedcouncilbi@gmail.com with their name, age, a contact email and phone number**. Posters will be judged by a local artist, a marine naturalist, and our State Senator Christine Rolfes! Participants must furnish the original artwork if their poster is chosen.
